## Sago Central to New MOU for Sustainable Agriculture in SHP

The Santos Foundation and Wonderland Agristock Limited (WAL), a community-based inclusive business that engages local people in agricultural enterprises, have embarked on an exciting new partnership, signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to elevate the status of sago in Kutubu.
